Stallion Breeding Donation Contract

This is to certify that I have donated a breeding to the Stallion Breeding Auction sponsored by AHA Region 9, Inc. to benefit Youth Foundation AHA Region 9, Inc (Youth Foundation). I am the legal owner or lessee of the stallion listed and have the legal authority to donate a breeding.

I understand that the terms and conditions are as follows:

1. 50% of monies received from the auctioned breeding will be donated to the Youth Foundation to be used in a manner consistent with Youth Foundation's corporate 501c3 purpose for the benefit of the youth of AHA Region 9 and is non-refundable. The remaining 50% to be retained by AHA Region 9 and awarded in the AHA Region 9 Futurity Program.
2. The **auctioned breeding is to be performed in 20____**, any extension of the breeding for and limited to one (1) year from this contracted breeding season is subject to specific negotiations between the purchaser of the breeding, the stallion owner and the AHA Region 9 Futurity Chair.
3. Purchaser of a breeding shall read and abide by all the conditions and terms outlined in the breeding contract of the owner of the donated stallion. All payments for board, vet, farrier and any other expenses (including collection and shipping fees) shall be paid directly to the stallion owner by breeding purchaser.
4. AHA Region 9 shall advise the stallion owner/manager within ten days the name of the purchaser. The purchaser shall communicate with stallion owner/manager by February 15, 20____ and coordinate closely with the stallion owner/manager to get the breeding consummated in a manner satisfactory to both parties.
5. The purchaser of a breeding at this auction cannot sell the breeding to another party without the written approval of the stallion owner. The AHA Region 9 Futurity Chair must be notified in writing of any sale.
6. In the event of death of the stallion for which a breeding has been purchased before breeding has been consummated, the stallion owner has the option of offering a stallion of equal quality. If the purchaser is not agreeable to the substituted stallion, the money actually paid to and retained by AHA Region 9 will be refunded. AHA Region 9 has the option of accepting the substituted breeding offered and selling it at private treaty.
7. AHA Region 9 Inc makes no warranties with respect to the condition of the stallion or as to any other conditions, stated or unstated, in the stallion owner's breeding contract. All parties to this agreement acknowledge that AHA Region 9, Inc. is merely a conduit for transfer of the services and shall not be deemed an owner in any sense. The owner of the stallion and the purchaser of the breeding waive any and all rights, whether at common law or statutory, against AHA Region 9 or the Youth Foundation should any breach occur with respect to the contract for breeding.
8. The stallion breeding donor will provide to AHA Region 9 an 8 x 10 color photo, four generation pedigree (typed), farm/breeding contact and, if available, a video/DVD of stallion and his get. The items will be used for promotional activities and will be provided by the stallion breeding donor no later than September 30, 20____ to be part of the publicity and promotional materials including the AHA Region 9 website, Youth Foundation website and the AHA Region 9 Breeding Donation List.
9. **Stallion owner/manager understands that sale of the donated breeding is of paramount importance to AHA Region 9 and to Youth Foundation. AHA Region 9/Youth Foundation are not responsible to supply bidders for any particular stallion. Stallion owners are encouraged to promote their own stallion by having an interested party available to register for bid, designate interest in that particular stallion and participate in that auction with an opening bid.**
